Overstocking of the snail pen is never economy. Stocking density affects the growth and breeding capacity of snails. Snails in overstocked pens tend to grow slowly, develop into smaller adults and lay fewer eggs even when food is abundant. Other disadvantages of over stocking are parasitism and high transmission of pests and diseases.

Choose only medium-sized snails for breeding. Large-sized snails are too old for breeding. The stock of breeders you select must be sexually mature snails with healthy shells. They should weigh at least 100-125 grams (0.2-0.27 pounds).
