APPLICATION TO RENT/SCREENING FEE

The maximum rental application fee in California is \$50 When California Civil Code §1950.6 was passed in 1997, the cap on rental application fees was \$30. But that limit is not fixed—the law allows landlords to increase the amount annually based on the Consumer Price Index. 1 As of 2018, the application fee cap had risen to \$50.94. 2

CALIFORNIA APPLICATION TO RENT/SCREENING FEE ASSOCIATION ...

In California, a landlord may charge an application fee that does not exceed \$49.50. This fee does not need to be refundable unless portions of the fee are not used in the screening process. The application fee is intended to cover a landlord's out-of-pocket screening costs and their time spent during the screening process.

California Tenant Screening Laws California laws tend to differ some from the other states. Here's some quick info you should be aware of as a landlord. As of 2012, the most you can charge for an application fee is \$49.50 and it should not exceed the landlord's actual out-of-pocket costs *dca.ca.gov

California Tenant Screening Background Checks

Application Fee (Cal. Civ. Code § 1950.6) - Initially, landlords could charge a maximum screening fee of \$30. This amount may be adjusted annually with the Consumer Price Index. As of February 2020, the maximum application fee is \$52.46.

Here are key provisions of the California law: Landlords may charge a maximum screening fee of around \$35 per applicant. This figure may be updated annually by changes in the Consumer Price Index for the nearest metropolitan area.

California Law on Tenant Application Screening Fees and ...

The point of a rental application fee in California is NOT to make a huge profit. This fee is only meant to cover your screening costs. Most application fees cost between \$30 and \$50 per applicant. Generally speaking, the screening fee you can charge is made up of two categories:

California Civil Code 1950.6 (a) states, in relevant part, "when a landlord or his or her agent receives a request to rent a residential property from an applicant, the landlord or his or her agent may charge that applicant an application screening fee to cover the costs of obtaining information about the applicant."

California Rental Application Law California state law legally limits the cost for credit check application fees landlords use to screen prospective tenants. The law regulates how much landlords can charge and the specifics landlords must comply with while accepting these fees for a credit screening check.
