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Formal Paper Guidelines

The guidelines for paper format apply to both student assignments and manuscripts being submitted for publication to a journal. If you are using APA Style to create another kind of work (e.g., a website, conference poster, or PowerPoint presentation), you may need to format your work differently in order to optimize its presentation, for example, by using different line spacing and font sizes.

General Guidelines Type your paper on a computer and print it out on standard, white 8.5 x 11-inch paper. Double-space the text of your paper and use a legible font (e.g. Times New Roman). Whatever font you choose, MLA... Leave only one space after periods or other punctuation marks (unless ...

General APA Guidelines. Your essay should be typed and double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11"), with 1" margins on all sides. Include a page header (also known as the "running head") at the top of every page. For a professional paper, this includes your paper title and the page number.

General CMOS Guidelines Text should be consistently double-spaced, except for block quotations, notes, bibliography entries, table titles, and figure captions. For block quotations, which are also called extracts: A prose quotation of five or more lines, or more than 100 words, should be blocked.

Format for a Research Paper Regardless of the nature of your research, if you are writing a paper an outline will help you to not only organize your thoughts, but also serve as the template for your entire paper. An outline for a research paper is a visual reminder to include all of the pertinent details of your research into your essay or paper.

Capitalize all terms defined in the policy, as well as those defined in the central Policy Glossary, each time they are used. Capitalize titles of individuals at Purdue when the title is referring to a specific person (e.g., "Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost").

An abstract is a brief summary of your paper that immediately follows your title page. According to APA format, your abstract should be no more than 100 to 200 words although this can vary depending upon the specific publication or instructor requirements. 2

APA Format: Basic Rules You Must Follow

Here are some general attributes that structure the analysis and argument for most policy papers: •Define the problem or issue. Highlight the urgency and state significant findings for the problem based on the data. Objectivity is your priority, so resist the urge to overstate. •Analyze—do not merely present—the data.

Listed below are some of the guidelines that you may incorporate into your writing so that your formal essay can look as professional as possible: Do not use redundant phrases. Repeating topics or content theme can make your formal essay boring. Repetitive statements can also irritate or bore your readers.

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Provide the reader with any necessary background/expository information. Insert your thesis statement somewhere near the end of your introductory paragraph.

APA format is the official style of the American Psychological Association. It is used in writing for psychology and other social sciences. These style guidelines specify different aspects of a document's presentation and layout, including how pages are structured, how references are organized, and how sources are cited.

Your title page should include a page number, article title, author name, and author affiliation. The seventh edition of the APA Publication Manual contained a few changes to the format of an APA style title page, including separate guidelines for student and professional title pages. Keep these pointers in mind:

APA Format Examples, Tips, and Guidelines

Double-space the entire research paper, including quotations, notes, and the list of works cited. Indent the first line of a paragraph half an inch from the left margin. Indent set-off quotations half an inch as well (for examples, see 76–80 in the MLA Handbook).
