Most manual transmissions used to use gear oil, specifically a GL-4 oil, since GL-5 would eat away "yellow" metals. Nowadays, many synchronizers are built using steel and paper clutch material, with smaller clearances, similar to the clutch packs that operate inside an automatic transmission.

Completely drain the transmission fluid. Connect the transmission fluid pump to a bottle and drain out all of the fluid. Pump a small portion of new fluid into the fill plug to flush out any contaminants. Ensure that you have a little more transmission fluid than the volume listed in your owner's manual.

Manual transmissions require more conventional gear oil rather than automatic transmission fluid and tend to be on a different maintenance schedule, so it's best to consult the service intervals ...

Remove your transmission's dipstick under the hood, and insert a funnel in its place. Refill with transmission fluid, then check the dipstick. Start the car and let it run for 10 minutes, then check the transmission's dipstick again. Top off the fluid if you need to.

To change gears properly, accelerate in first gear until the RPM gauge hits the 3 (3000 RPMs). Then, remove the right foot from the gas, push the clutch all the way in, and move the shifter to second gear.
