Examine the "ligule," the meeting of the leaf blade with the main stem of the grass. Bahia, Bermuda and Zoysia grasses have a few hairs along their edges, while native Buffalo grass is quite hairy.

One of the key identifying characteristics of perennial ryegrass is the back of the leaf blade which is very shiny. You can also pull some grass out of the soil and look at the base of the stems. If the stem base is a reddish purple, it's perennial ryegrass.

Look at the leaf fold of the individual blades of grass. There are two types of lawn grass leaves, folded leaves and rolled leaves; this is called the "vernation." The vernation of bent grasses and zoysia is a rolled form when the blade is new. You will find folded vernation in new blades of centipede, fine fescue and St. Augustine.
