General Laws Chapter 13, Sector 45 authorizes the Board of Registration of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors ("the Board") to establish continuing education requirements for licenses. As of this date, the Board has not imposed the requirement of continuing education on licensees.

Engineering Firm licensure is not required on the State level in Massachusetts. Engineering firms may need to file a regulatory board certificate with the secretary of state prior to forming a professional entity. To become licensed, engineers must complete a four-year college degree, work under a Professional Engineer for at least four years, pass two intensive competency exams and earn a license from their state's licensure board. Then, to retain their licenses, PEs must continually maintain and improve their skills throughout their careers.

After completing a four-year college degree from an ABET-accredited engineering school, candidates must become an engineer intern (EI) or engineer-in-training (EIT) by passing the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam.

Is a Professional Engineer License Worth It?

The state of Massachusetts requires the professional engineer stamp to be 1 1/2 inches in diameter. We offer the Massachusetts professional engineer stamp in one size; 1 1/2 inches. If you select an electronic stamp with a signature, your signature will be placed under the stamp per board regulations.
