6. USING EVALUATION FINDINGS

Both approaches are appropriate in how you report your findings, but use only one format. Present a synopsis of the results followed by an explanation of key findings. This approach can be used to highlight important findings. For example, you may have noticed an unusual correlation between two variables during the analysis of your findings.
