A septic system should effectively accept and treat liquid wastes from your home. Its ultimate purpose is to prevent contaminants from entering the groundwater and nearby wells, lakes and streams. Installing a new conventional septic system can cost from 4,000 - 5,000 + -. Alternative systems may cost in the range of $10,000 - 20,000 \dots$ or more.

Set it level where it's going through the wall or under the footing, and from there run with about an 1/8" per foot of pitch (slope) toward the septic tank. Go further or all the way into the tank if required. If not, switch to 4" 3034 with the appropriate adapter and pipe toward the tank with 3034.
